Sub: Burning problems of the Railwaymen
Ref: Undersigned's discussion with you

During the course of discussions with you time and again, the following issues, related to the Railwaymen, were raised. But still these have not been resolved. These need immediate redressal to control the anger of the Railwaymen:-

- (i) Creation of additional posts for additional works.
- (ii) Filling-up of vacancies
- (iii) Stop indiscriminate surrendering of posts.
- (iv) Implement Liberalized Safety Related Retirement Scheme immediately
- (v) Recruit wards of Railway employees in the Railways
- (vi) Appoint High Powered Committee to review duty hours of Running and Safety categories staff
- (vii) Early payment of arrears of Running Allowance
- (viii) Improve rates of Running Allowance
- (ix) Settle the issue of entitlement of Privilege Pass at an early date
- (x) Settle the issues of revision of designations and classification of posts as "Selection/Non-Selection"
- (xi) Exemption of the allowances from the purview of Income Tax

- (xii) Remove anomalies of VI CPC early.
- (xiii) Redeployment/retention of catering staff on deemed deputation to IRCTC.
- (xiv) Early implementation of 15% upgradation of apex grade Supervisors/Sr. Section Engineers in Gazetted Cadre and also grant them GP Rs.4800.
- (xv) Poor maintenance of railway staff quarters, roads, sewage system and proper supply of water and electricity.
- (xvi) Stop outsourcing/off-loading of perennial nature works.
- (xii) Absorb the staff working in the quasi-administrative offices in the Railways
