Sub: Emoluments reckoned for calculating retirement/deathbenefits of staff working in the Construction Organisations

Ref: Board's letter No.F(E)III/2007/PN1/4 dated 19.8.2010

In continuation of this office letter of even number dated 24th September, 2010, it is stated that, in terms of para 5.1.33 of the report of the 6th CPC, pension should be paid at 50% of the average emoluments received during past ten months or pay last drawn whichever is more beneficial to retiring employees. This has been circulated vide Railway Board's letter No.F(E)III/2008/PN1/13 dated 10.10.2008(S.No.1). The clarification issued vide Board's letter under reference is quite contradictory to the provision made in the above cited para of the VI CPC report.

Hence, Board are requested to issue revised orders in consonance with the recommendation of the 6th CPC, clarified vide Board's letter dated 10.10.2008.
