Sub: **Running Staff Conference on 9-5-2010 at Mumbai.**

Since it is expected that large number of delegates of Running Staff may turn out for the Conference from all zones it is necessary that we should seek some facilities from the Railways. We may write for the following facilities to the Railway Board.
