**Sub: Revision of number of posts of Sr. AA(5% of SO) – Merger of pay scales**  
**Ref: Railway Board's letter No.PC-V/2007/PNM/DC-JCM/1 dated 17.5.2010**

**As per the decision arrived in the DC/JCM meeting, held on 27-28 August, 2010, against DC/JCM item No.22/2007 and 22/2007, 5% of the posts of Section Officer(Accounts) in the pre-revised scale of Rs.6500-10500 are earmarked for the promotion of Accounts Asstt. Rs.5500-9000(pre-revised scale) who could not qualify Appendix-III(IREM) Examination on the basis of seniority.**

**VI CPC has replaced pre-revised grade of Rs.6500-10500 with PB-II GP Rs.4800 and also the posts of Section Officer(Accounts) and Sr. Section Officer(Accounts) have been merged and granted GP Rs.4800.**

**Due to merger of S.O. and S.S.O. posts and granting of common Grade Pay of Rs.4800, the necessity for re-calculation of 5% of combined sanctioned strength is arisen and there is likelihood of increase in the number of posts if re-calculation is done by reckoning 5% of combined sanctioned strength of SOs and SSOs.**

**The Board are requested to issue necessary orders to re-calculate 5% of combined sanctioned strength and also to grant the benefit to more number of eligible employees.**
