Dear Shri Vivek Sahai Ji,

Sub: Absorption of the staff working in quasi-administrative offices/organizations connected with the Railways in the Railways

Your kind attention is invited towards above subject issue which is already figuring in DC/JCM regular agenda item No.27/2006, wherein official side has been urged upon to revise the provision so as to facilitate absorption of the staff working in quasi-administrative offices/organizations connected with the Railways.

It may be recalled that this issue has been raised by us several times at different levels, including with the Member Staff, Addl. Member Staff, Adviser(IR), Railway Board and the then Member Staff Shri A.K. Goyal had agreed to the view point of AIRF, whereupon information was collected from different zonal railways in respect of such staff who are on roll in the quasi-administrative offices/organizations directly related to the Railways.

It is understood that desired information is already available in the Railway Board's office as of now and the issue is still hanging fire due to one reason or the other.

You are also aware that above issue was to come up for discussion on 5th May during recent meeting of DC/JCM Forum, scheduled to be held on 4-5 May, 2011, which unfortunately could not be discussed due to postponement of 2nd day meeting.

Since the staff engaged in the quasi-administrative offices/organizations between the period 1997- 2000 are awaiting absorption in the Railways since long and AIRF is regularly pursuing this matter with the Railway Board, there is deep sense of frustration prevailing among them because of uncertainty of their future.

I would, therefore, request your personal intervention in the matter so as to resolve this problem once for all facilitating absorption of the above mentioned staff against Group 'D' vacancies in the Railways without any further delay.
