Sub: Promotion of Group `D' staff(Helpers Grade-I and II) in Workshops, Divisions, Diesel/Electrical/EMU Loco Sheds and Production Units against Direct Recruitment Quota

Ref: Railway Board's letter No.E(NG)/2006/PM7/19 dated 7.8.2006

The Railway Board vide their letter referred to above had directed the General Managers of the Indian Railways to extend promotion to the Helpers working in the Workshops, Divisions, Diesel/Electric Loco/EMU Sheds and Production Units to the post of Technician Grade III in Pay Band 1, GP Rs.1900 by diverting respective Direct Recruitment Quota vacancies and adding the same to Promotion Quota as a one-time measure up to 31.7.2007 subject to passing prescribed trade test.

Above orders of the Railway Board facilitated a large number of staff to get promotion during that time.

Now, the Group `D' staff of the said units are demanding extension of these orders for a further period for filling-up of Direct Recruitment Quota vacancies from among the available Group `D' staff.

The Board are requested to issue necessary orders on the subject early.
