

Record Note of Discussion held with Staff Side on 18.01.2011 regarding DC/JCM Item No. 11/2010: Rates of stipend to trainees/apprentices on the Railways and DC/JCM Item No. 3/2006: Implementation of negotiated settlement reached between the Federations (NFIR/AIRF) and Railway Board in the Chamber of Adv.(IR)

DC/JCM Item No. 11/2010: This may be discussed in a separate meeting with FC. The Staff Side also contented that the quantum of stipend need to be uniform.

DC/JCM Item No. 3/2006: It was agreed that in respect of the following issues, further action will be taken as mentioned below:-

Issue raised	Remarks
Item No.1 Grant of ALK to medically decategorised running staff posted as PC/CC.	A separate meeting is to be held as per minutes of the last DC/JCM meeting.
Item No. 3 Problems of Departmental catering staff working on deemed deputation under IRCTC.	New catering policy has since been evolved and procedure to streamline the cadre has been issued vide letter No. E(NG)I/2003/TR/10 dated 28.12.2010. However, Staff side stated that many issues raised by them are still unresolved and hence a separate meeting is necessary.
Item No.6 Quasi-administrative offices/organization - Restoration of Board's instructions vide letter No. E(NG)III/77/RR1-5 dated 26.08.1977:- It was agreed that the demand would be examined. It seems no action has been taken so far.	The matter to be re-examined. Staff side demanded that since there are lakhs of vacancies hence all the Quasi-administrative employees can easily be accommodated as per Railway Board's letter No.E(NG)III/ 77/RR1-5, dated 26.08.1977, and as a 1 <sup>st</sup> step, those on rolls as on 30.05.2000 should be absorbed as agreed to in the previous meeting.

<p>Item No. 7 HOER- Running Staff and other Safety categories. It was agreed that a High Power Committee with an eminent Judge of High Court would be constituted to look into all the above issues. Committee has not been set up till date.</p>	<p>Setting up of a High Power Committee is under process. Staff side expressed disappointment over the delay.</p>
<p>Item No. 8 Counting of full temporary status service of Casual Labour:- The Railway Ministry was fully convinced about the justification of this demand and assured that due action will be taken to convince the Finance Ministry. There has been no progress so far.</p>	<p>This will be examined. Staff side insisted the Railway Ministry should again approach DOP&amp;T and Finance Ministry with proper justification.</p>

It was agreed to close the other issues.

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
